Rock Creek Resort is a master-planned, exclusive gated community located on the Texas shores of beautiful Lake Texoma, located 60 minutes north of the Dallas/Ft. Worth metroplex. With over 1,300 lush acres, Rock Creek will combine the best of serene lakeside living with all the amenities of an upscale resort. Rock Creek Resort on Lake Texoma features a Nicklaus Design Golf Course and Pro-Shop and will feature a Yacht Club and Marina, Clubhouse, Exhilarating Spa and Fitness Facilities, Swimming Oasis, Tennis Court, Health Trails, and an On-site Activities Director. Lake Texoma attracts approximately 6 million visitors a year and is about an hour north of the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The lake area includes two wildlife refuges, two state parks, fifty four USACE-managed parks, twelve marinas, twenty-six resorts, hundreds of campgrounds and a variety of excellent golf courses. Power boating, sailing, personal watercraft, water skiing and wind surfing are all popular pursuits

The lake is one of the seven U.S. inland lakes where striped bass reproduce naturally instead of being farmed and released into the waters. The "stripers" feed on large schools of shad, and often reach sizes of 12 to 20 pounds.

Recreation

Eisenhower Birthplace State Historic Site: Located in the heart of Denison, Eisenhower Birthplace State Historic Site showcases the home where the 34th U.S. President Dwight David “Ike” Eisenhower was born in 1890. Antique furnishings fill the modest frame house, illustrating the working class life of the Eisenhowers. The visitors center celebrates Ike with memorabilia and exhibits featuring his many accomplishments as president and war hero. A larger-than-life statue of the general, landscaped grounds and picnic tables round out the place where everything started for the first Texas-born president.

Grayson County Frontier Village: Take a walk back in time to the days when pioneer Grayson County residents used hand tools to shape logs notched together at the corners to form one-room cabins, some with lofts for added space to house families of six or more. The Village Museum is filled with interesting historical artifacts from years past plus many photos of people, places and events in this area.

Other nearby recreations: Cross Timbers biking trail, fishing tours, Main Street showcase and 416 West Gallery Denison.

Fun Fact

In 2004, a blue catfish was pulled from the lake weighing in at 121.5 pounds, temporarily setting a world weight record for rod and reel caught catfish.
